The State Energy Program (SEP) is intended to promote energy conservation, lower energy demand, and reduce our dependence on imported oil. Some regions of New Jersey are serviced by municipal utilities where contributions to the Societal Benefits Charge (SBC) are not possible. SBC charges ultimately fund the NJCEP energy efficiency programs. In these cases SEP funds are available to allow businesses to participate in NJCEP.

With SEP funding, HealthSouth Rehab Hospital of New Jersey took advantage of the Direct Install program and its incentives which cover up to 70% of total project costs. Doing so enabled them to proceed with a comprehensive project which consisted of installing DLC and Energy Star qualified LED lighting and lighting controls throughout the facility. In addition, the project also included (3) new packaged rooftop HVAC units (10T, 15T, & 5T RTU's) along with a variety of HVAC controls for additional energy savings.
